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1 ASSESSMENT STRATEGY

1.1 Assessment Model

An external integrated summative assessment, conducted through the relevant QCTO Assessment Quality Partner is required for the issuing of this qualification. The external integrated summative assessment will focus on the exit level outcomes and associated assessment criteria and will be conducted through an electronic assessment. The external integrated summative assessment will be conducted at a TETA recommended and QCTO accredited decentralised assessment centre and evaluated by assessment specialists registered by the TETA for this purpose.

The written assessment will take place over a minimum of 1 working day. A candidate who attempted an external assessment will be given recognition for those assessment tasks in which he/she has been found competent and not be retested in those tasks provided that:

- (1) The learner is competent in at least 70% of the task given during the assessment, and
- (2) The recognition will be retained by the candidate for a maximum of 3 attempts or 18-months from the date of successful completion of the assessment tasks whichever comes first.

1.2 Qualification Purpose

The purpose of this qualification is to prepare a learner to operate as a Supply Chain Practitioner.

A Supply Chain Practitioner develops operational schedules and action plans to coordinate service delivery in the supply chain in accordance with customer requirements and performance objectives and manage customer/end user relationships.

A qualified learner will be able to:

- Develop and coordinate operational schedules for supply chain operational plans (NQF Level 5)
- Monitor execution of supply chain operational schedules (NQF Level 5)

Integrated Assessment Focus Area 1: Develop and coordinate supply chain operational plans and schedules (60%)

Associated Assessment Criteria

- Developed operational schedules are aligned with operational plans and performance objectives and covers all functional responsibilities
- Description of processes for the coordination and communication of supply chain operational schedules implementation is comprehensive

Integrated Assessment Focus Area 2 Assess execution of supply chain operational schedules and contract management (40%)

Associated Assessment Criteria

- Evaluation of supply chain operational activities is comprehensive and re-scheduling processes indicated
- Requirements for contract implementation and service level agreements monitoring is comprehensive

- The ability to monitor and manage contract and service level agreement deliverables
- The ability to track performance in terms of delivery schedules and initiate corrective measures
- The ability to develop plans to implement corrective actions where required
